The OCC Men's Golf team finished 5th at the Saginaw Valley State university golf tournament. Anthony Provenzola finished tied for 4th with an even par 144 for the 36 holes. Jim Uelmen finished tied for 7th with a total of 146 for the tournament. OCC recently competed in the Motor City Invitational at Edgewood Country Club, in which the team placed ninth.

Women's Volleyball - Coach Bryan Lindstrom, & Assistant Angie Schmidt

The women hosted the 6th annual Mike Lindstrom Memorial Tournament this past weekend at the Highland Lakes (results - 10/8/07). The Raiders went 3-3 in the tournament. Based on their record in pool play, the Lady Raiders advanced to the semi-finals for the first time in tournament history and faced MCCA A Eastern Conference leader Macomb CC. Macomb CC, who went on to win the tournament, defeated OCC. Lauren Forshee and Haley Weddle both were named to the All-Tournament Team.
