

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program will be effective for the 2008-09 academic year. TEACH is a grant program which will provide up to \$4000 a year for students who plan to teach full-time in high-need subject areas at schools who serve students from low-income families.

Teaching Obligation:

Grant recipients must agree to teach for at least four years within eight years of finishing their teacher preparation program and to teach high-need subjects in designated schools. Students who do not fulfill this obligation will have their grant converted to an unsubsidized loan with interest calculated back to the beginning of the grant.
