A native of Detroit and Farmington Hills, Margaret M. Kelly received her Associate Degree in Accounting in 1979 from Oakland Community College, where she attended the Orchard Ridge Campus as Margaret Topolewski. She went on to receive a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in Finance and Accounting in 1981 from Walsh College.

After graduation, Margaret served as Financial Analyst for Metropolitan Hospital and Health Centers. She moved to Denver, Colorado in 1982 where she was affiliated with American Medical International and held the positions of Financial Analyst, Manager of Budgeting and Financial Analysis and Manager of Alternative Services Financial Planning and Analysis.

Margaret joined RE/MAX, one of the world's largest networks of real estate agents, as a Financial Analyst in 1987.

She was promoted to Member Services Representative for RE/MAX of Colorado in 1989, and to Regional Director for Colorado in 1992. That same year, the five-state region known as RE/MAX Mountain States was formed and Margaret was promoted to Vice President/Regional Director to oversee operations in the region. She also served as Vice President / Zone Director for company operated regions until 1997 when she was named Senior Vice President, supervising development activities in 18 states representing seven RE/MAX Regions in the United States as well as regional operations covering five provinces in Western Canada. In October 1999, Margaret became Senior Vice President of External Operations. In this capacity she administered planning and programs with RE/MAX vice presidents of commercial franchise development, international expansion, member and customer relations and all zone operations.

She was named President of RE/MAX International in April 2002 and oversees all operations of RE/MAX International.

Margaret is a frequent speaker and moderator at RE/MAX Conventions and on RE/MAX Satellite Network (RSN). A breast cancer survivor herself, she heads the RE/MAX nationwide co-sponsorship of the Komen Race for the Cure Survivor Recognition program

She is a member of the Board of Trustees of The Wildlife Experience, a unique Southeast Denver museum and civic venue that promotes wildlife conservation through many forms of art and a variety of educational tools.
