

*Please Note That Courses Are Sequential*

1. All students must successfully complete NUR 1520, NUR 2512, NUR 2520, and NUR 2530 to be able to register for NUR 2540.
  2. Priority II students must successfully complete the remaining required support and general education courses with a grade of "C" or above in each course for progression in the nursing program and graduation.
- \* Applies to students registering for OCC classes for the first time or being enrolled Fall 1985 or thereafter.
- \*\* One course must be completed from the Physical Education courses listed in the General Education list. Applies to students registering for OCC classes for the first time or being enrolled Fall 1986 or thereafter.

## Oakland Community College Second Year Associate Degree Nursing Completion Program Modified Career Ladder Graduates



The OCC Highland Lakes Department of Nursing provides an opportunity at the **Southfield Campus** to graduates of the Modified Career Ladder Practical Nurse (MCL-PNE) program to apply for selection into the second year of the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) program. The course of study requires completion of 31.5 credits and leads to an Associate in Applied Science Degree. Successful completion of the second year requirements qualifies the graduates to apply to write the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). Satisfactory achievement on this examination qualifies the graduates for licensure as Registered Nurses (RNs).

*Note: Certain other regulations apply. Conviction of a felony may preclude eligibility for licensure. Contact the Michigan Board of Nursing*

## Selection Procedures and Requirements

All applicants who seek selection into the ADN Program must have in their file by **OCTOBER 15**:

1. A curriculum designation of "RNE".
2. An accurate address and phone number.
3. Evidence of graduation from the OCC MCL-PNE Program.
4. Evidence of attendance at a RNE Nursing Information Session.
5. Written approval of any course substitution and/or an OCC evaluation of any transfer credits taken at another college or university. An official transcript from any previously attended institution must be sent to the Registrar's Office (OCC, 2480 Opdyke Rd., Bloomfield Hills, MI 48304-2266.
6. A checklist signed by a counselor at the Highland Lakes or Southfield Campus.
7. A valid and current Michigan License as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

Applicants with *less than three (3) years* from the time of graduation to the time of starting the ADN completion year must be currently employed in a healthcare setting.

## Application Process

Students wishing to be considered for admission must contact the Nursing Department and submit a completed application to the Nursing Department no later than **OCTOBER 15**.

## Selection Criteria

1. Selection is *conditional on the availability of clinical space and faculty* in the second year of the ADN Program.
2. Eligible applicants who have fulfilled the above admission procedures and requirements are placed in two priorities:
  - a. **Priority I** includes applicants who have completed all of the following courses with a "C" or better grade:
    - Arts or Humanities (3 or more credits\*)
    - ENG 2200 or ENG 1520
    - PER (1 credit\*)
    - POL 1510
    - SOC 2510

- b. **Priority II** includes applicants who have completed the following courses with a "C" or better grade:
  - ENG 2200 or ENG 1520
  - SOC 2510

3. Selection for the program is made initially from Priority I applicants. Priority II applicants are selected only after Priority I is exhausted.
4. Applicants with the earliest date of graduation from the MCL/PNE Program will form the top of the order in **EACH of the PRIORITIES**. If necessary, the overall GPA in the NUR courses will be used as a tie breaker. For a second tie in Priority I, the number of support and general education courses completed at OCC will be used as a tie breaker. For a second tie in which two or more Priority II students have the same date of graduation and the same GPA in the NUR courses, the greatest number of the following required courses that are completed by the applicant will be used as a tie breaker.

5. Students admitted to the program as Priority II must complete all of the remaining required support and general education courses in the sequence and time frame indicated in the curriculum plan with a "C" or better grade. Students must successfully complete each nursing course with a grade of "B-" or above to progress. Notification of the selection decision will be sent by certified mail by **DECEMBER 1**. Students not selected, who wish to be considered in subsequent years, must reapply to the program by **OCTOBER 15** of the academic year they wish to enroll in the program.
