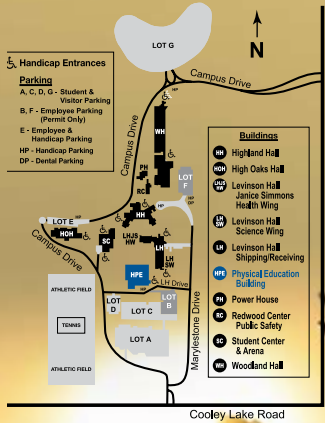

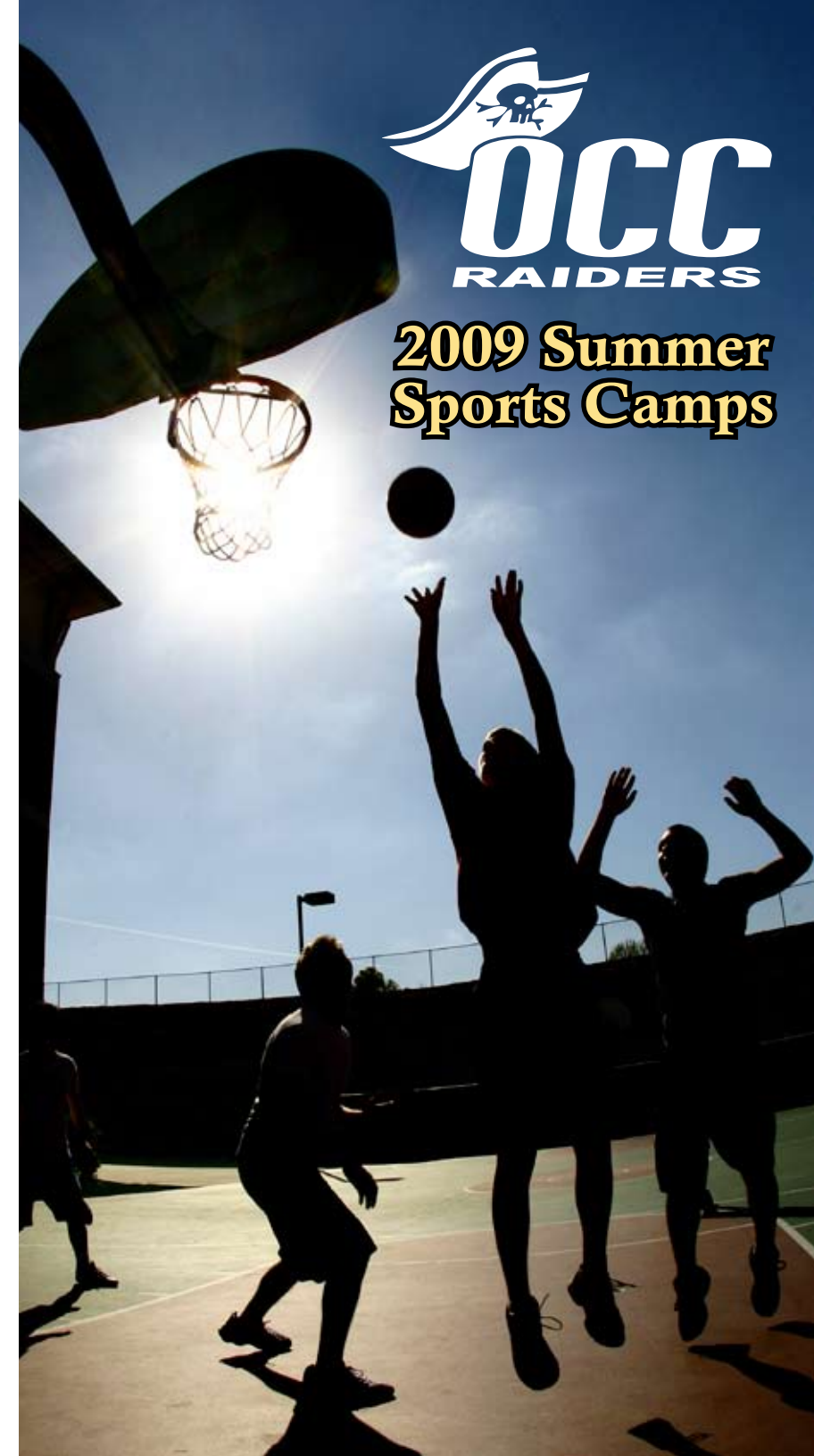

Individual Camp is designed for campers to get those last minute touches in before tryouts and to start developing a team system. Head coach Bryan Lindstrom of the OCC Raiders will spend roughly an hour and half going over team strategies - offensive, defensive, and serve receive drills. The OCC Raiders Volleyball team will demonstrate the drills and then each team will go through the drill on their court. Teams will then play various wash drills and game scenarios for the remainder of the camp. There will also be a team tournament officiated by OCC players.
