Men's / Women's Cross Country – Coach Tony Baracco, & Assistant Coach Eric Green

Both the Men's and Women's Cross Country teams competed at the MCCA/Region XII Meet and the NJCAA National Championships recently. The men's team finished 5th in the region and 29th in the Nation. The women's team finished 2nd in the region and 14th in the Nation.

Women's Volleyball – Coach Bryan Lindstrom, & Assistant Angie Schmidt

The women's volleyball team had one of the best seasons in school history by posting 19 wins. They finished fifth in the league by posting a 9-7 record. This marked the first time in nearly two decades that the team has finished better than .500 in conference play.

The men's basketball team has started 2-2 on the season. On November 2nd and 3rd, they swept their two games at the Annual OCC Tip-Off Tournament, defeating Rochester College JV and Lorain (OH) County CC.
