

Highland Lakes Construction Information

The campus paving project will begin on Monday, May 11. This summer's project includes the the following paving work:

- Highland Lakes Drive and Campus Drive from Hospital to Cooley Lake Road
- Parking lots A, B, C, and D.
- Levinson Hall Drive
- Road to the Grounds Building

The project has been structured into four phases in order to help ease the inconvenience to the campus community.

- Phase 1 includes the repaving of the roadway from Hospital Road to the Woodland Hall receiving driveway.
- Phase 2 includes the repaving of the roadway from Woodland Hall receiving to Student Center receiving
- Phase 3 includes the repaving of the roadway from Student Center receiving to Cooley Lake Road
- Phase 4 includes the repaving of parking lots A, B, C, and D

During the months of May and June, the contractor will focus on grinding up the old asphalt and installing a base layer of new asphalt. They will work their way through the campus until all areas have the first coat. Once completed, they will make a second pass through the campus to install the top layer of asphalt. Once a phase has its first coat applied, it will be reopened to traffic and the work will move on to the next phase area.

Work on Phase 1 will necessitate the shutting down of the Hospital Road entrance, Highland Lakes Drive, and parking lot G for approximately two weeks beginning on Monday, May 11. During that time, all traffic must enter and exit from Cooley Lake Road, and student parking will be limited to A, C, and D lots. Attached is a campus map showing the extent of Phase 1. Please keep in mind that the paving work is weather dependent. Heavy rains will delay the project, so hopefully it will be a dry spring.

If all goes well, we plan to repave parking lot G next summer.
