



The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) protects the privacy of student education records. Oakland Community College cannot release any personally identifiable information contained in a student's educational records without the prior written consent of the student. Spouses, relatives and parents (of students 18 years of age or older) are included in those restricted from free access to student information. (The law does grant certain privilege to parents of dependent children under 18). Students may grant a third party access to selected personal information when said party is acting as an agent of that student as may be variously defined from time to time. Oakland Community College does not abrogate any of its rights, under this procedure, which permit denial of access to information deemed not appropriate in the instant circumstance.
