



**OCC Student Life Committee
Report to College Senate
April 22, 2004**

In Winter 2004, the OCC Student Life Committee accomplished the following tasks:

- 1) Each campus has prepared a schedule of Student Life programs, services and activities and a recommended budget for 2004-05. Events planned for each site next year range from campus forums and job fairs, to political debates, student appreciation days, intramural sporting activities, "Family Nights" and student leadership workshops.
- 2) A college-wide budget has been recommended that will support the OCC Speakers Series and increased opportunities for Student Development Fundable Proposals projects.
- 3) The Oakland Community College Vision of Student Development was approved by the Senate in February, and will be published in the 2004-05 college catalog:

Oakland Community College meets a wide range of student development needs and encourages students to meet their goals both inside and out of the classroom by offering a variety of "student life" programs, activities and services. We place special emphasis on the following aspects of human development:

- Intellectual
 - Moral/Ethical/Global/Diversity
 - Self/Personal
 - Interpersonal/Social
 - Career
- 4) Representatives from each campus' Student Life Committee met with OCC staff from Marketing and Publications to create strategies for effectively and efficiently promoting Student Life events to our students, faculty, staff and surrounding communities.
