



OCC Student Life Committee Goals 2004-05:

- Establish appropriate college and campus staff structures for coordinating Student Life activities, events, programs and services.
- Create a student leadership program.
- Promote student engagement in campus governance and committees (e.g., Campus Senates, Facilities Committees, Diversity Committees, etc.)
- Provide funding for special projects via Student Development Fundable Proposals “mini grants” to individuals and groups around the college that create new student development opportunities.
- Strengthen college and campus budgets for supporting Student Life activities, events, programs and services appropriate to OCC’s Student Life Vision and Student Development Outcomes.
- Coordinate OCC Speakers Series, providing four speakers throughout the year on topics addressing student development needs.
- Collect core set of assessment tools for measuring effectiveness of Student Life activities, programs and services. Assist campuses with gathering and responding to assessment information. Use assessment information in Student Life program planning and budgeting cycles.
- Create quality promotional materials targeted at students advertising college-wide and campus-based programs, activities and services for Fall 2004 and Winter 2005.
- Create a communications campaign targeted at students to promote the OCC Student Life Vision, Student Development Outcomes and Student Development Planning Model.
