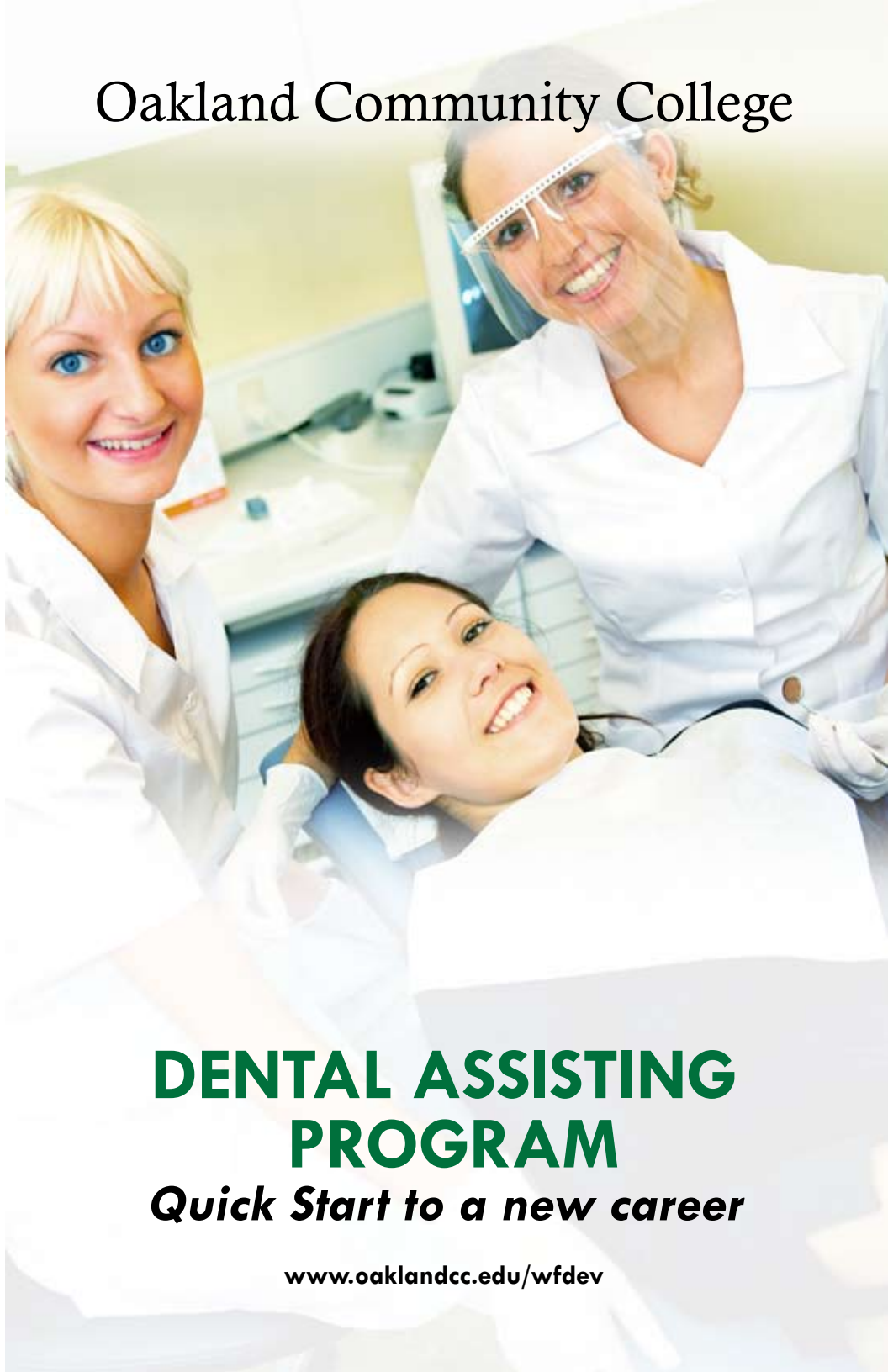

Quick Start to a new career as a **DENTAL ASSISTANT**

This program will prepare the student as an entry-level **Dental Assistant**. Radiography training is now required under Michigan law. 10-week (237 hours), tuition, books and materials for \$2,950

Skills Acquired:

- Preparation of the Treatment Area
- Instrument Maintenance and Infection Control
- Ability to assist Dentist in Four-Handed Dentistry
- Use of Dental Materials for Preliminary Impressions
- Preparation of Diagnostic Models
- Basic Dental Radiography
- Techniques for Learning
- Customer Service
- Employability Skills

Certificates:

- After completing the radiography class the student should be prepared to take and pass the Michigan Dental Association Radiography exam. A passing score of 75% or better is required to obtain the certificate.
- A career readiness certificate is also available upon completion of the program providing the student passes the Career Readiness certification exam.
- A certificate of achievement from Oakland Community College will be issued to students that successfully complete all course work and receive the Michigan Dental Association Radiography certificate.
