The Federal Work-Study (FWS) Program is a need-based financial aid program in which students may be employed by OCC (on campus) or be employed off campus by certain agencies, private nonprofits, and for-profit organizations. College work-study is funded by the federal government and Oakland Community College. The Federal Work-Study Program provides earnings to help meet the costs of postsecondary education.

A Federal Work Study award does not need to be paid back.
