The Sterile Processing Technician Program is designed to give entry-level and incumbent healthcare workers the experience, knowledge and skills necessary to become certified as a Sterile Processing Technician. These positions are responsible for decontaminating, inspecting, assembling, packaging and sterilizing reusable surgical instruments or devices in a healthcare facility

Program Information:

This program includes 44 hours of classroom instruction toward exam preparation and 44 hours of on site clinical experience in a sterile processing department at a partnering hospital.

Individuals will have the classroom knowledge required to sit for the Certification Board of Sterile Processing and Distribution Exam.
