The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act, recently passed by Congress, provides \$3,737,183 to Oakland Community College to distribute directly to students in the form of emergency grants. The grants help cover expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the Coronavirus.

Funding will be disbursed to eligible students enrolled in the Winter 2020 term, as of March 13, on a first-come, first-served basis until funds run out.

In order to be considered for this award, please complete the following steps:

1. COMPLETE your 2019-20 FAFSA.
**Students who have not submitted for academic year 2019-2020, have until June 30, 2020 to complete the application.*
2. SIGN UP for direct deposit on MyOCC – Student Menu>Financial Profile.
3. APPLY for the emergency grant award on OCC's scholarship application website.
