PUMP APPARATUS OPERATOR

Do you have personnel that need to learn how to operate your apparatus . . . CORRECTLY?

INSTRUCTORS: Capt. John Smilnak (retired) - John Smilnak retired from the Livonia Fire Department as Senior Captain after 30 years of service. During that time he served as Apparatus Officer where he was involved with apparatus/equipment purchases as well as training on pump operations. John has a teaching background that spans all aspects of fire apparatus operations and includes Basic Pump, Advanced Pump, Aerial, and Foam Operations, as well as various other topics. He has taught at the basic and advanced level for both municipal and industrial fire departments.

Jim Lee (retired) - Jim Lee retired from the Livonia Fire Department as Senior Fire Apparatus Chief Mechanic after serving from 1973 to 2001. Jim has an extensive military and private career as heavy truck/equipment mechanic. Jim has also taught Fire Chassis/Fire Pump Operations and Fire Pump Testing for many fire departments. In 2002 he became the Chassis and Fire Pump Trainer for new product delivery for Halt Fire Equipment Inc.
