### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #1 *Initial Investigations*

A five-day course that trains officers to recognize and record all pertinent physical evidence at serious accident scenes. Sketching, measuring, basic photography, roadway and vehicle evaluation, and basic speed determination are taught.

**DATES:** January 28 - February 1, 2019  
**COST:** \$795.00

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #2 *Follow-up Investigations*

A sequel five-day course to AI-1 covering such follow-up functions as preparing scale drawings, mathematical calculations via formulas/equations, reaction distances, and case studies. **NEED:** Calculator

**DATES:** February 25 - March 1, 2019  
**COST:** \$795.00

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #3 *Accident Photography*

This two-day course teaches officers how to take useful and comprehensive traffic accident photographs. Major topics are basic camera familiarization, daytime photography, and nighttime (flash) photography.

**DATES:** March 25-26, 2019  
**COST:** \$375.00

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #4 *Protocol, Techniques & Procedures*

A one-day course that covers developing procedures for and using established protocols during accident reconstruction with a focus on proven techniques applied to real world cases. Topics covered include: the Scientific Method, Initial Documentation, Tires, Brakes and Braking Systems, Vehicle Fluids, and Wheel Separation.

**DATE:** March 27, 2019  
**COST:** \$240.00

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #5 *Tire Dynamics and Examination*

This one-day course helps the investigating officer to determine whether tire failure contributed to the accident and, if so, whether the failure took place before, during or after the collision. It also covers the role of tires in vehicle handling.

**COST:** \$240.00

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #6 *Lamp Examination*

This one day seminar is designed to assist investigators to determine whether vehicle lamps were "on" or "off" at the time of impact. Also, covers the proper procedure for removing and storing damaged vehicle lamps.

**COST:** \$240.00

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #7 *Commercial Vehicle Accident Investigation*

A five-day course covering those aspects of truck and bus accidents that differ from ordinary passenger-car crash dynamics. This course covers such topics as weight shift, truck braking systems, heavy vehicle components and variable drag factors. The course has been updated and includes the new CDL information with amendments to the commercial vehicle rules and regulations along with information on doubles. If you have taken AI-7, you may consider taking it again since the course content has been updated and revised. **NEED: Calculator with square root function and Measuring Device Template or Engineer's scale. PREREQUISITE: Michigan State University's Accident Investigation #1 and 2 or equivalent.**

### ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #8 *Motorcycle Accident Investigation*

A course focusing on technical aspects of investigating traffic accidents involving motorcycles, mopeds, and bicycles. **NEED:** Calculator
