THREAT PATTERN RECOGNITION AND PPCT USE OF FORCE INSTRUCTOR

INSTRUCTOR: Joseph (Little Joe) Ferrera, Sergeant - Southfield Police Department, Retired. Joe is a staff instructor for the Human Factor Research Group and at the Oakland Police Academy. Joe has over 40 years of police experience and spent 30 years training police officers across the country.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will provide the newest research in the area of officer survival during an unexpected close-quarters firefight. This research examines Human Factor Sciences, which is the study of human capabilities and human limitations within a specific domain.

This research has led to the current system of teaching threat pattern recognition and a specific response selection to deal with the threat. This training will help officers respond faster to threat cues.

- Shoulder Pin Restraining Technique
