HANDLING THE DESPONDENT AND SUICIDAL CALLER

INSTRUCTOR: Dave Larton, Operations Section Chief of First Contact 911, LLC, has over thirty years of emergency services experience, along with being a certified Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) Peer Counselor, a COM-T (Communications incident Technician), and a Basic Law Enforcement instructor with Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Education (TCLEOSE). Dave also co-authored "Incident Dispatcher: A Guide for the Professional, Tactical and Incident Dispatcher."

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Crisis callers are some of the most stressful situations that a 9-1-1 telecommunicator may face. Whether caused by a hostage taker, suicidal subject, a domestic violence situation or traumatic event, calltakers and dispatchers need the knowledge to establish trust and rapport with the caller, while gaining valuable intelligence for the responders. **Module II approved.**
