PISTOL INSTRUCTOR SCHOOL

Presented by Oakland Police Academy Firearms Instructors

This 40 hour training program is designed to provide the student with the comprehensive knowledge and skill needed to instruct, administer and supervise in-service pistol training.

The class format includes classroom lecture in conjunction with student demonstrations in range exercises. Students will learn to evaluate and correct errors in shooting and decisions. Students will make classroom presentations as well as assume command of the firing line during range operations. Students will be exposed to instruction techniques, offer survival mind-set including body and brain reactions in high stress situations and range operations.

PREREQUISITE: Students must possess basic marksmanship skills to attend this course and are required to shoot a modified marksmanship phase of the MCOLES pistol qualification course the first morning of the training. The course of fire consists of shooting 12 rounds in 70 seconds at 45 feet from the standing position. All rounds **MUST strike** inside the marksmanship (center) ring of the MCOLES TCQ-95 target for students to receive a passing score.

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: All leather gear, ball cap, on duty and off duty firearm, flashlight and pistol manufacturer's manual. Be prepared to bring your departmental policy, qualification and cleaning equipment.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Officers/supervisors planning to become certified departmental firearms instructors.
