MANAGING 911 STRESS

INSTRUCTORS: Paul Logan has more than 30 years of 9-1-1 experiences. He currently serves as Operations Manager of Dane County (Madison, WI) Department of Public Safety Communications. In this role he manages 35 position PSAP with 75 dispatchers and 8 supervisors. This PSAP provides service to more than 65 agencies. Paul has managed numerous major projects including the consolidation of 3 PSAP's (and staff) into 1, implemented new CAD, radio and telephone systems, and became the first PSAP in Wisconsin to implement ASAP to PSAP for alarms.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This class will cover the causes, signs and symptoms of stress, its effects on our physical and mental well-being, and give you some realistic alternatives towards managing that stress. We'll also discuss how dispatch Peer Counselors may be a valuable asset to your Dispatch Center, and make you aware of Critical Incident Stress Debriefings and Defusings that help take the mental pressure off your team if they've worked that Officer Down, Line of Duty Death or other Critical Incident.
