ELIGIBILITY: Candidates will be admitted upon the written recommendation of a Chief, Director or Sheriff of a law enforcement agency, and will be subject to the rules and regulations of the Oakland Police Academy during the training sessions.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: Trainees must provide sidearm and leather gear.

All students **must** have:

- Duty Type Firearm: **No sub-compact weapons**
- Duty type holster with at-least a Level I retention.
Any higher retention level is **not** required or recommended
- 3 magazines
- Double magazine pouch. Triple would be approved
- Hat
