911 ETHICS AND LIABILITY FOR DISPATCHERS

INSTRUCTOR: Paul Logan has more than 30 years of 9-1-1 experiences. He currently serves as Operations Manager of Dane County (Madison, WI) Department of Public Safety Communications. In this role he manages 35 position PSAP with 75 dispatchers and 8 supervisors. This PSAP provides service to more than 65 agencies. Paul has managed numerous major projects including the consolidation of 3 PSAP's (and staff) into 1, implemented new CAD, radio and telephone systems, and became the first PSAP in Wisconsin to implement ASAP to PSAP for alarms.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This class will cover not only 911 liability issues but 911 *ethics* which are sometimes not addressed with liability training. Call-taking standards and special liability considerations will be included. This class will include group exercises and discussions. This training is highly recommended for **all** 911 staff. **Module II approved.**
