BASIC, INTERMEDIATE AND ADVANCED EMT TRAINING INFORMATION

BASIC EMT:

This program is designed for persons directly involved or intending to become involved in Emergency Care Services (e.g., ambulance employees, fire department EMT's). Successful completion of all of the required courses will make the student eligible take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) Examination and give them certifications for CPR, Hazardous Materials Awareness and Vehicle Extrication.

Based upon the minimum requirements necessary of the didactic and practical courses, students will be scheduled at local emergency departments to accomplish the clinical portion of the program. Clinical rotations will be scheduled with local ALS Fire Departments and private ambulance services.

All students interested in enrolling in The OCC Basic EMT Program must attend an OCC EMS Orientation to be eligible for registration. This course is approved by the State of Michigan Department of Community Health EMS Division. Participants that successfully complete this program will be eligible to take the National Registry Examination for licensure in the State of Michigan as a Basic EMT.

PARAMEDIC:

This program is designed for persons who currently have attained that status of Basic EMT and would like to advance their training to the Paramedic level. Successful completion of all of the Paramedic courses will make the student eligible take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) Paramedic Examination and give them additional certifications for CPR and ACLS. Completion of this program and obtaining a State of Michigan Paramedic License will provide students with employment opportunities with Ambulance Agencies, Fire Department Advanced Life Support (ALS) units, or hospital emergency centers that require paramedic skills.

All students that have completed their Basic EMT training here, at The OCC EMS Program, are not required to attend an OCC EMS Orientation. All students that have completed their Basic EMT training at a facility, other than The OCC EMS Program, must attend an OCC EMS Orientation to be eligible for registration. All OCC EMS Orientations for new paramedic students are completed by appointment. Please contact The OCC EMS Program at (248) 232-4232 to schedule an Orientation. This course is approved by the State of Michigan Department of Community Health EMS Division. Participants that successfully complete this program will be eligible to take the National Registry Examination for licensure in the State of Michigan as a Paramedic.

All OCC EMS Program students must pass a criminal background check and drug screen prior to starting the Basic, Intermediate or Paramedic programs.
