PEDIATRIC ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT (PALS)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The PALS course give healthcare professionals the knowledge and skills required to better recognize and treat critically ill infants and children. A team orientated approach is used to teach pediatric emergency management of a pediatric patient approaching or already in respiratory or cardiac arrest. PALS emphasizes the importance of basic life support CPR to patient survival, the integration of effective basic life support with advanced cardiopulmonary life support interventions, and the importance of effective team interaction and communication during resuscitation. Each student will receive didactic and case based scenarios within an interactive learning environment.

REALISTIC SIMULATIONS REINFORCE THE FOLLOWING KEY CONCEPTS:

- · Recognition and treatment of infants and children at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest
- Systematic approach to pediatric assessment
- Effective respiratory management
- Validate skills for one and two person CPR and AED skills for infants and children
- Defibrillation and synchronized cardioversion
- · Performing intraosseous needle insertion and fluid bolus administration
- Effective resuscitation team dynamics
