Accident Reconstruction

A ten-day seminar covering various aspects of scientific traffic accident reconstruction such as acceleration, time-distance studies and the determination of vehicle speeds via kinetic energy and conservation of linear momentum. NEED: Calculator and AI2 drawing kit which has angles, protractors and rulers.

PREREQUISITE: Michigan State University's Accident Investigation #1 and 2 or equivalent.

ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION #11

Night Visibility

A two-day course on vision, night visibility factors and lighting requirements. It is intended to assist in making a determination of whether a driver could have and should have seen an object in sufficient time to avoid striking it. Since a night visibility field exercise is included, Day 1 starts in the afternoon. (Dress for the weather conditions as field exercises will be conducted outside.)
