FIRST RESPONSE TO JAIL CRIMES

INSTRUCTOR: Brian Valentine, Sergeant Ingham County Sheriff's Office (Retired). During his career Sergeant Valentine has worked as a Corrections Deputy, Road Patrol, Undercover narcotics, and in the detective bureau.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: In this day and age of downsizing and budget cuts, it's becoming more common for county jails to be housing high-profile, and more dangerous criminals. This of course increases the possibility of correctional assaults and other crime scenes. This course is designed for correctional officers, the first responders to any type of jail assaults or incidents. The main focus is twofold: First, to help prepare correctional officers for securing major crime scenes that occur in jails, what to do and what not to do, to help the investigators and secondly, some basic guidelines for handling minor criminal and in-house violations themselves, ensuring proper processing and handling of potential evidence. The course will address ways correctional officers can assist in more serious investigations due to their daily interaction with known criminals and the potential for obtaining information. The course will cover inmate complaints against correctional officers, an important aspect of correctional investigations, especially for supervisors; and a multitude of tips/pointers designed to make your personnel better correctional officers.
