FORGERY DETECTION, STATEMENTS AND HANDWRITING ANALYSIS

INSTRUCTOR: Joseph Lucas of Forensic Document Examiners has been involved in Forgery Detection since 1983 and is a court qualified Document Examiner. He is an approved instructor of Handwriting Identification/Document Examination in 28 states where he instructs investigators on forgery detection and handwriting identification and the author of *“Red Flags on Forged Checks”*: *A guide to the detection and defense of spurious checks”*.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Students will gain the knowledge and skills required to analyze documents for authenticity (forgeries) and deception while obtaining powerful tools that will be used for pre-interrogation purposes. Students will learn to do multiple interrogations simultaneously as well as determine who is “holding back” and who is making up stories.
