El Camino de Santiago Program: May 10 to May 24, 2026



Program Description

Earn up to 9 academic credit hours at the International College of Seville (ICS). Walk the Camino de Santiago then return to Sevilla to complete ICS June Intensive Summer Program.

Cost

El Camino de Santiago Program: \$3,700

Program Includes

- Tuition and program fees
- Homestay in single room with shared bathroom and laundry
- Twenty-one meals with option to request a “meal-to-go”
- Cultural excursions of the Culture and Society of Spain.
- Trips to Cordoba and Morocco

Application Deadline

February 15

Eligibility

- 18 years or older
- 2.5 cumulative GPA (on 4.0 scale)
- Completion of at least 12 college credits by the time of departure
- Completion of one college writing course (commonly known as English Composition I and/or II, or its equivalent) with a grade of B or better, by the time of departure.
