| Stop discussion | "I move the previous question" | Yes | No | No | Two-thirds |
| To lay aside temporarily | "I move to lay on the table" | Yes | No | No | Majority |
| To take from the table | "I move to take from the table" | Yes | No | No | Majority |
| To bring back for further consideration | "I move to reconsider the vote on" | Yes | No | ?** | Majority |
| If you cannot reconsider because of time lapse | "I move to rescind the action taken." | Yes | Yes | Yes | Without notice, two-thirds*** |
| Approve action taken previously | "I move to ratify the action" | Yes | Yes | Yes | Majority |
| Request information | "I rise for information." | No | No | No | No vote |
| If you doubt the vote | "I call for division." | No | No | No | No vote |

^{*}The motion to postpone indefinitely opens the main motion to debate again.

Steps in securing action on a main motion:

- 1. Member:
 - Rises and addresses the chair "Madam/Mr. President"
 - Awaits recognition "Chair recognizes Miss/Mr. (name)"
 - Makes the motion "I move that...."
- 2. Another member seconds the motion.
- 3. The chair:
 - States the motion
 - Ask, "Is there any discussion?"
 (Is there any debate?")
 ("Are you ready for the question?")
 - Takes the vote or (Puts the question.)
 - Announces the result of the vote. (Voice note. "The ayes/noes have it, the motion is adopted/lost and the effect of the motion, if needed.)



^{**}The motion to reconsider is debatable if the motion to which it is applied is debatable.

^{***}When notice is given, or there is a majority vote of the entire membership, the motion to rescind requires only a majority vote.
