## Who can be a Student Ambassador? A Student Ambassador:

- is a current OCC student taking a minimum of 6 credits per semester
- has completed 12 credit hours at OCC (at the time of application)
- ♦ has a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher
- is available to serve as an ambassador during the fall and winter semesters

### What do Student Ambassadors do?

Ambassadors work 50 hours per semester, for both the fall and winter (a total of 100 hours), in the following areas:

- ◆ Providing assistance at the welcome areas on campus
- ◆ Representing the College at campus events
- Working with faculty and staff to promote and support campus activities
- Guiding students to rooms and events during the first week of classes
- Attending 10 hours of leadership training meetings during the semester
