Jan 14 - Feb 4

Candidates interested in running for SG Executive Board at your home campus must submit an application electronically to the Associate Dean's office. E-mail occstudentlife@oaklandcc.edu to obtain this application form. Applications must be received by the Associate Dean at your official home campus. There will be no exceptions.

Week of Feb 6

Applications will be reviewed for approval by the end of the first week in February. Upon approval, candidates will be notified via e-mail to set up an interview with the nominating committee.

Week of Feb 11

During this week, potential candidates will go through an interviewing process to be held by the nominating committee. Candidate announcements from the nominating committee shall be provided no later than the end of the second week of February.

Feb 18 - April 1 Each candidate will be allowed to "campaign" for a period of six weeks, commencing the third week of February until election day.

Week of Mar 18 Debates (presidential and vice presidential candidates only) if there is more than one candidate.

Week of April 1 Elections will be held the first full week of April each year. No more than two candidates for each position will run for office in the final election. Elections shall be decided by the majority of the vote.
