- Students must have an overall GPA of a 2.0 in order to be eligible for admission consideration to Rochester University and the BS -Early Childhood Studies program.
- Students should meet with an OCC Counselor prior to following this Articulation Agreement Program Guide.
- Deviation from this guide may result in non-transferable and/or applicable OCC coursework, resulting in additional requirements.
- This guide does not include any remedial courses and may not include prerequisite requirements.
- This Articulation Agreement Program Guide includes the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) and additional Rochester University degree/program requirements beyond the A.A.S. degree requirements.
- Rochester University requires that a minimum of a "C" (2.0) be earned in each course in order to be considered for transfer credit, non-germane and remedial courses may not qualify for transfer credit.
- The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) requires a minimum of a "C" (2.0) grade be earned in each applicable course in order to fulfill the category requirement and to receive the MTA endorsement.
- \*Preferred course selection and required for the Rochester University, BS Early Childhood Studies program. Deviation may result in additional coursework at Rochester University after transfer.
- \*\*Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) applicable courses are listed in the OCC Catalog. The Fine Arts/Humanities, Social Sciences and Natural Sciences requirements must be from two different disciplines.
- \*\*\*Elective Credit to be selected in consultation with an OCC Counselor to ensure the transferability and utilization of the course at Rochester University.
