- This Articulation Agreement Program Guide includes the remaining Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) requirements beyond the A.A.S. degree requirements and additional applicable credit hours.
- \*Preferred course selection and required for the Rochester University, BS – Nursing program. Deviation may result in additional coursework at Rochester University after transfer.
- \*\*Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) applicable courses are listed in the OCC Catalog. The Fine Arts/Humanities, Social Sciences and Natural Sciences requirements must be from two different disciplines.
- \*\*\*Elective Credit to be selected in consultation with an OCC Counselor to ensure the transferability and utilization of the course at Rochester University.
